

CDS HEAD START CHILD OUTCOMES - FY 11-12

During the 2011-2012 school year 56.36% of the Head Start programs utilized Galileo online. Childhood Development Services, Inc. (CDS) uses the Galileo G3 Assessment system to measure child outcomes. The Galileo G3 Assessment Scales are fully aligned with the 2011 Head Start Child Development and Early Learning Framework. The program can assess children's learning in the 11 Sub-Domains of the Framework

2011-2012 DEVELOPMENTAL SCORES IN THE FIVE ESSENTIAL DOMAINS

The program as a whole showed significant progress in the 5 core domains Our Head Start children usually start the school year below the national averages in Galileo. Language and Literacy experienced a 63 point increase. This is significant progress since this area had the lower scores. 17% of our Dual language learners moved from intermediate to advanced development level
